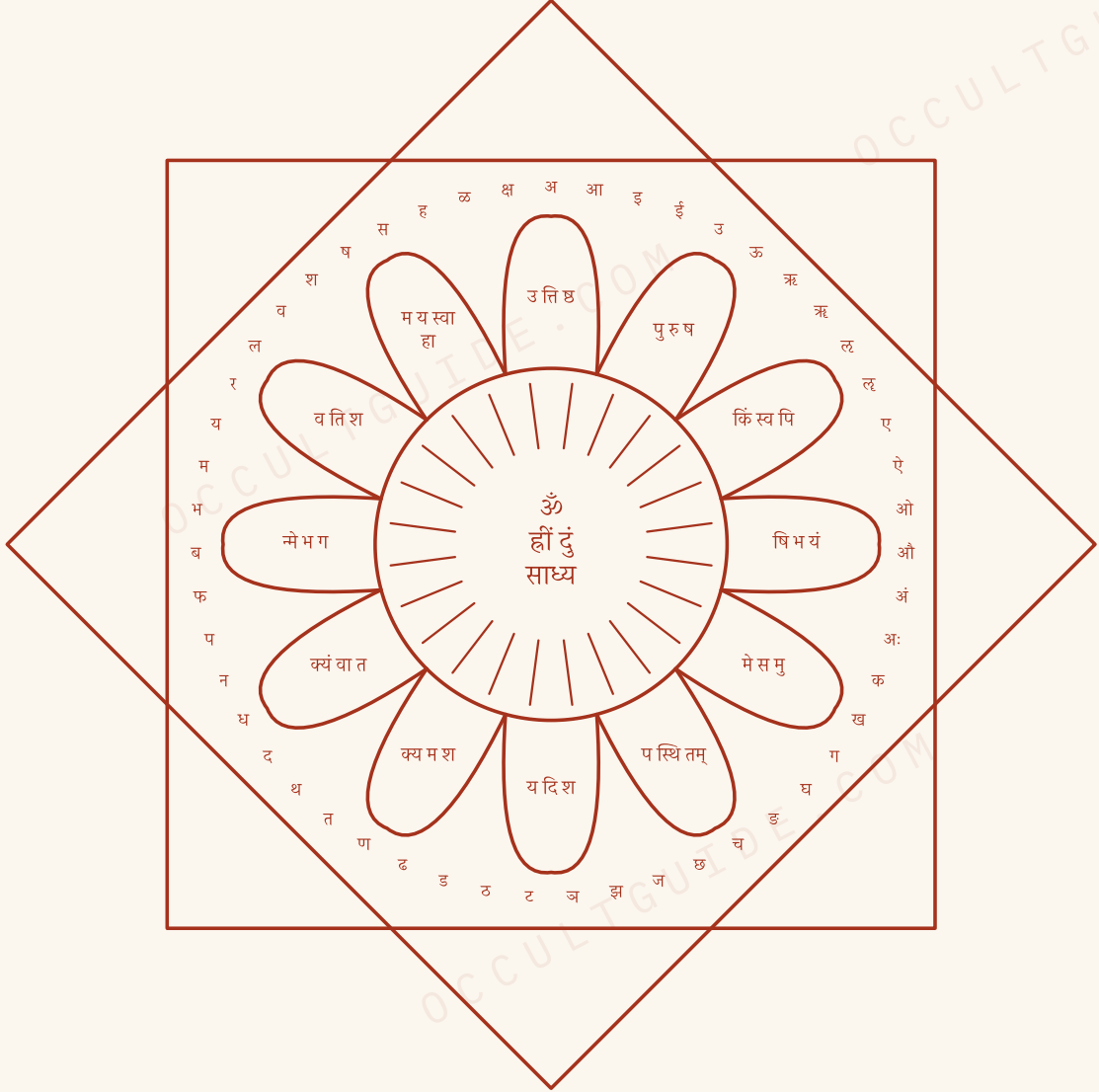


बृहत्तन्त्रसारः

The yantra of the nine Durgās: the praṇava, the śakti bīja and the sādhyā in the pericarp of a twelve-petalled lotus, the mantra three letters to a petal, the alphabet round it and two earth-squares.

नवदुर्गा यन्त्रः बारह दलों के कमल की कर्णिका में प्रणव, शक्ति-बीज और साध्य, दलों पर तीन-तीन अक्षर मन्त्र, चारों ओर मातृका और दो भूपुर।
