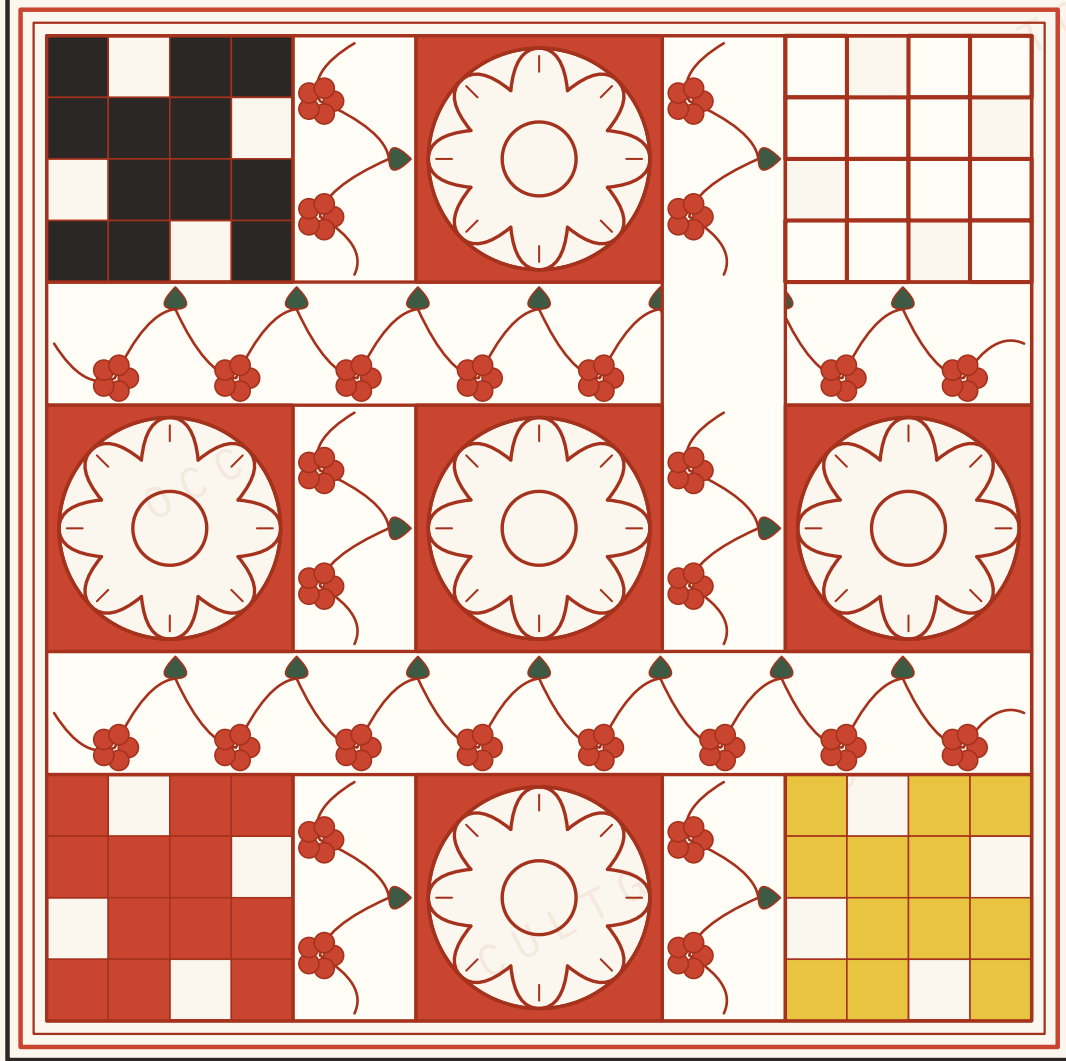

The navanābha maṇḍala: sixty-four cells with a lotus in the middle and in the four directions, creeper galleries between, and a svastika in each corner block powdered white, yellow, red and black from the north-east.
