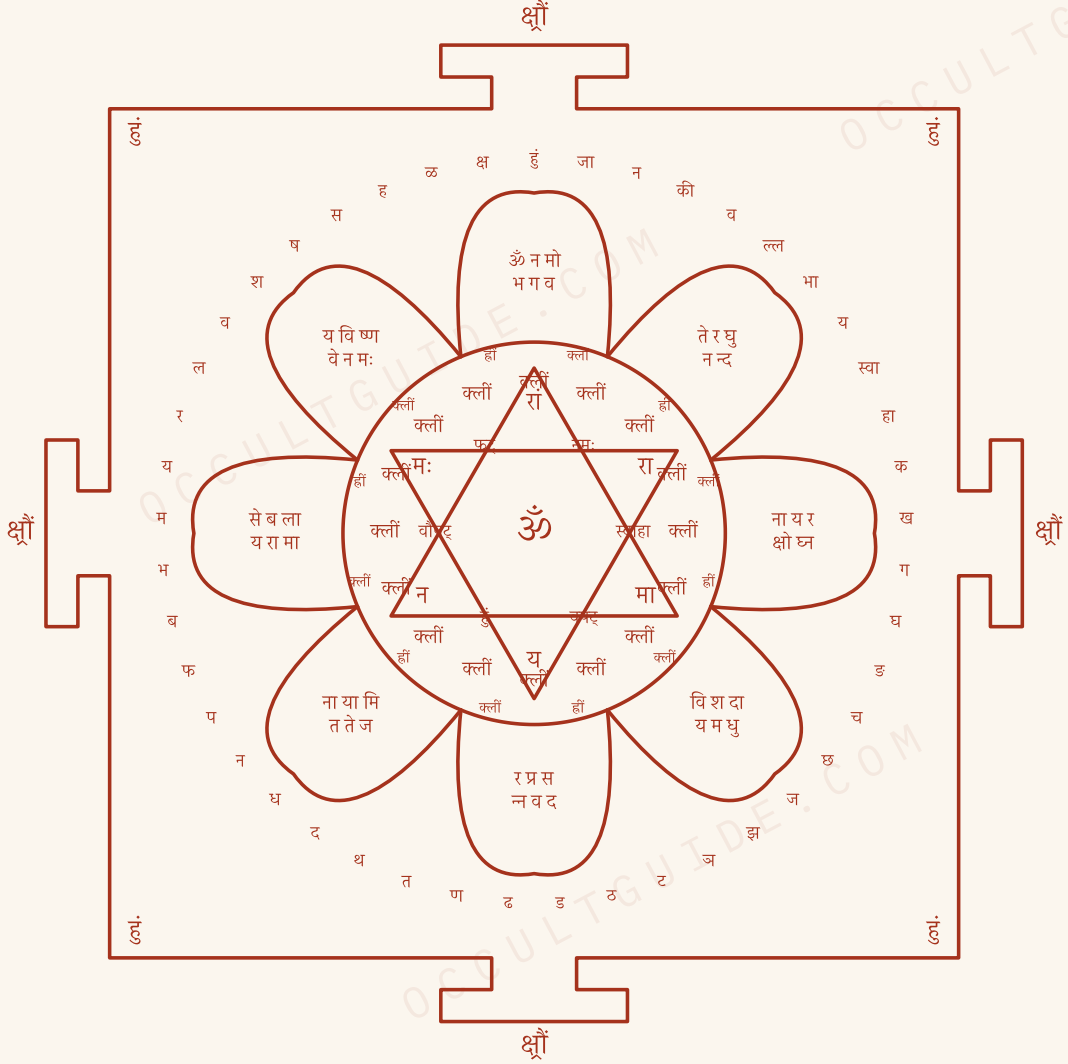

The Śrī Rāma yantra: the praṇava in a hexagram carrying the six-lettered mantra and the limb mantras, the mālā mantra on eight petals, the ten-lettered mantra and the consonants round it, and an earth-house with the bījas of Narasiṃha and Varāha.

श्रीराम यन्त्रः षट्कोण में प्रणव, कोणों पर षडक्षर मन्त्र और सन्धियों पर अङ्गमन्त्र, आठ दलों पर मालामन्त्र, चारों ओर दशाक्षर मन्त्र और व्यंजन, तथा नृसिंह और वराह के बीजों सहित भूपुर।
