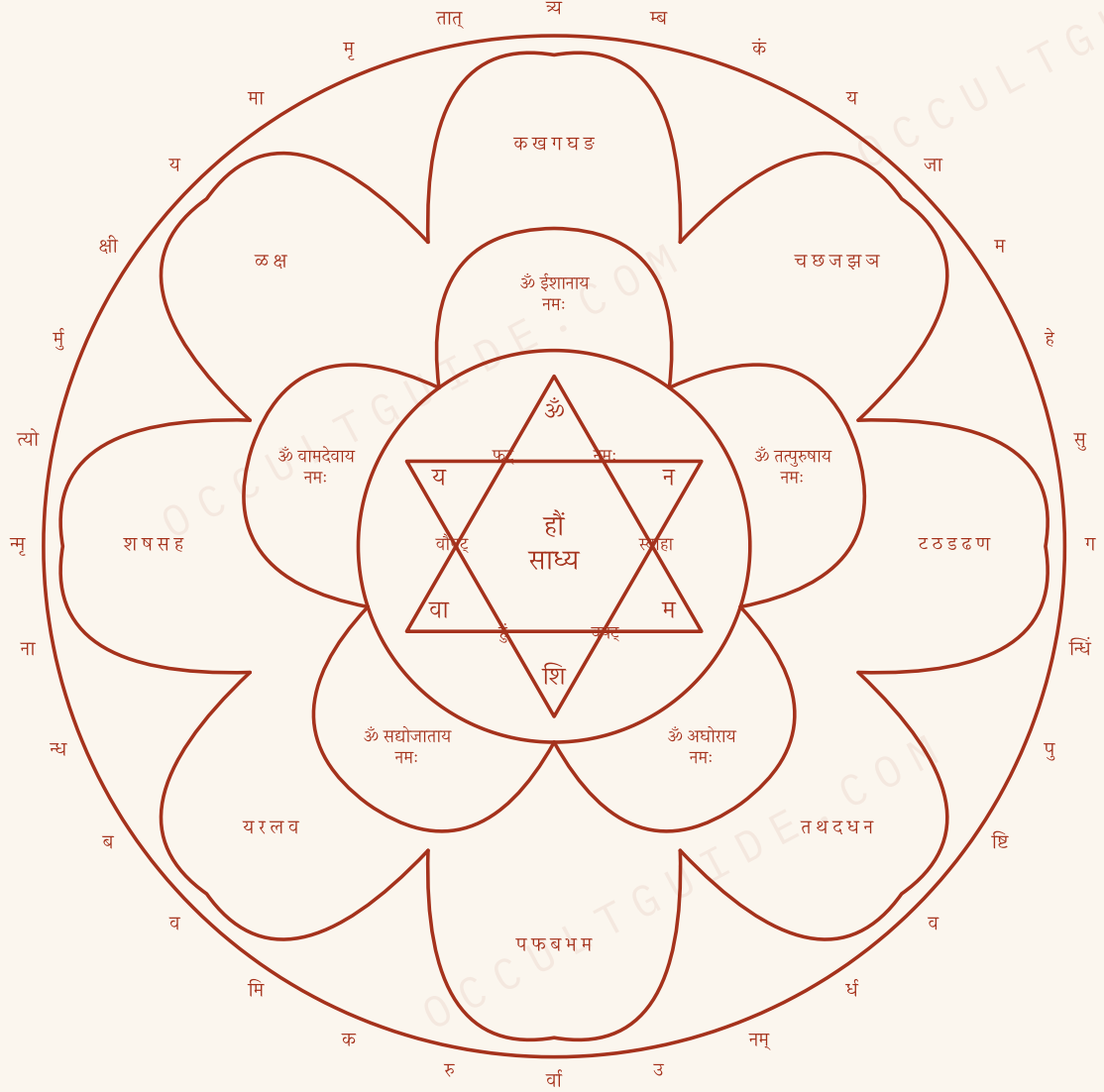


बृहत्तन्त्रसारः

Bṛhat Tantrasāra · Fifth Pariccheda · Chapter 5: The Yantras Worn on the Body · 13



The Śiva yantra: the prāsāda bīja and the sādhyā in a hexagram with the five-lettered mantra in its corners and the limb mantras in its joints, five petals with the mantras of the five faces, eight petals with the alphabet and a circle wound with the Tryambaka mantra.

शिव यन्त्रः षट्कोण में प्रासाद-बीज और साध्य, कोणों पर पञ्चाक्षर मन्त्र और सन्धियों पर अङ्गमन्त्र, पाँच दलों पर पाँच मुखों के मन्त्र, आठ दलों पर मातृका और त्र्यम्बक मन्त्र से वेष्टित वृत्त।
