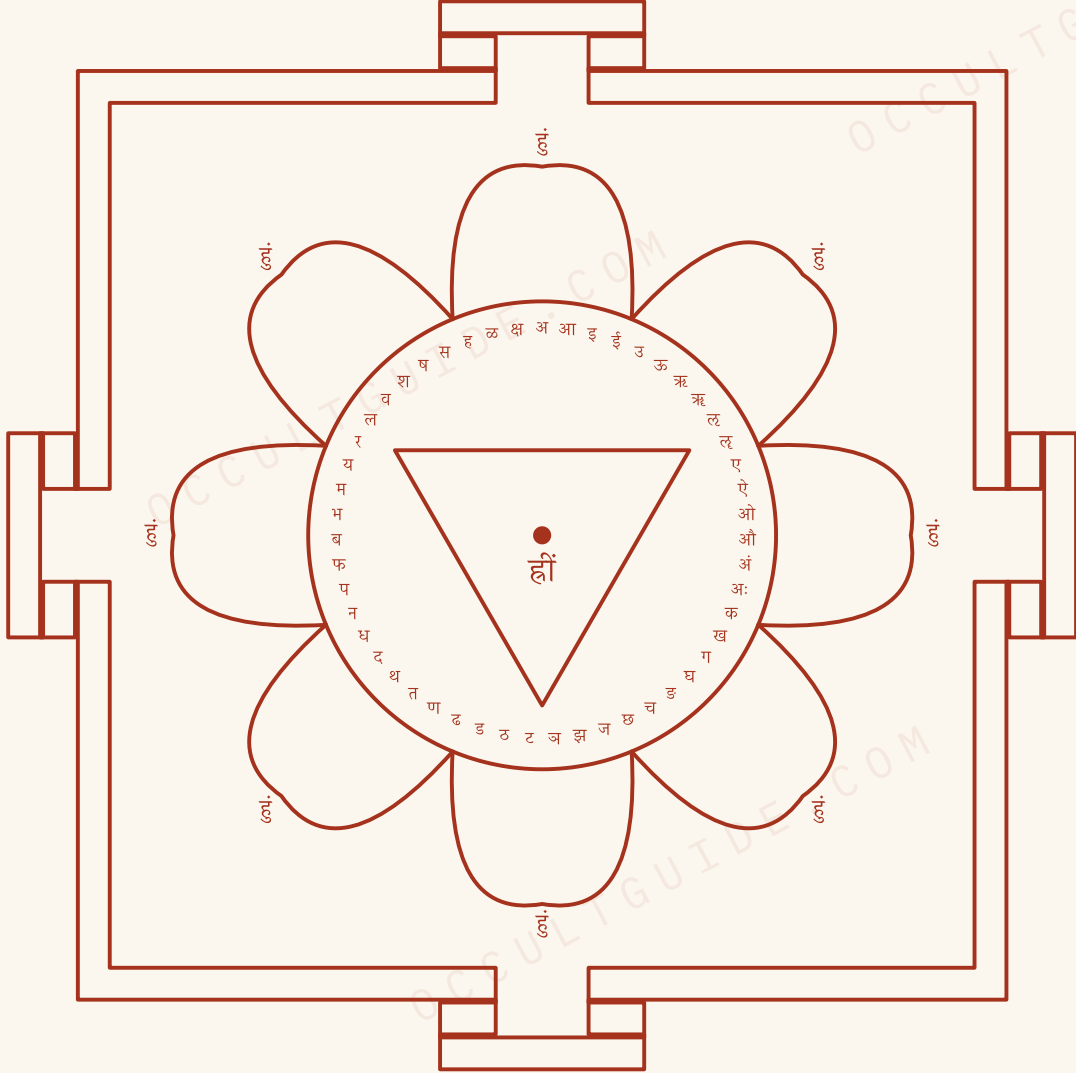


बृहत्तन्त्रसारः

The yantra of Tvaritā, the giver of all protection: eight petals, a fire-triangle, an earth-square and a point; hūṃ at the eight corners and hrīṃ ringed by the alphabet in the middle.
